Imaging Center Upholds Commitment to Patients and Physicians by Planning Ahead to Fill Coverage Gaps

It's an all too common story for many imaging centers and hospitals across the country. The full-time staff physician approaches a well-deserved vacation and the healthcare facility where he works faces the challenge of continuing seamless operations without any lapse in quality patient care while he is out.

Dana Carpenter, RTRM, Operations Manager of four MRI & Imaging of Georgia facilities owned by Medquest Associates faced a similar challenge when her full-time radiologist submitted a request for vacation time. Carpenter's part-time radiologist who handled gaps in coverage had recently retired. "I knew I had to find coverage quickly to keep operations flowing smoothly."

For the Imaging Center of Warner Robins, Warner Robins, GA, coverage is extremely important because the center is a full modality one. In-house coverage is required for contrast, plain x-rays, and mammography. The facility sees about 50 patients per day and performs an average of 28 MRIs daily. A decision to block the schedule would have resulted in a multitude of problems both operationally and financially. According to Carpenter, contrast coverage is approximately \$4,000 per week, and coupled with other procedures that require an in-house radiologist the cost to block the schedule would have exceeded \$12,000 per day. Finally, proposing a vacation reschedule would have resulted in one unhappy radiologist, and most likely would have lead to retention problems. But, Carpenter also faced a tougher challenge – each of the Medquest facilities are supported by board certified radiologists and a network of fellowship-trained radiology specialists who provide service to referring physicians affiliated with the finest medical institutions in the country; therefore it was critical for the fill-in radiologist to be expertly trained and up to par in all imaging techniques and modalities.
